1. E/A attacks on this group - Nil.
2. Observations of Military Importance -
 - a. 1410 - 4749-1014 ½ - 18,000 a battered A/F but no planes seen.
 - b. 1416 - near Alps - 18,000 - saw about 75 ski troops.
 - c. 1504 - 4818-1152 - 17,500 - Power dam.
 - d. 1505 - Freiburg - 4822-1143 - 17,400 - Freiburg heavily smoking.
 - e. 1455 - bet. Target and Froising - 18,000 - Saw numerous German convoys moving in direction Of 155 degrees.
 - f. 1507 - Freising - M/Y burning.
 - g. 1510 - 18,000 - Schwetenkirchen - Large motor convoy proceeding northeast from Munich to Regensburg.
 - h. 4735-1210 - 18,000 - Saw military installations of about 40 barracks.
 - i. Observed every other building in target area covered with Red Cross insignia.
